


Renewable energy (utility-scale wind and solar) is a critical part of Montana's **energy economy.**

**Stillwater County** 

Renewable energy helps fund **vital community improvement projects**.

In just 2024, Stillwater County received

\$1,117,747

in property tax revenue from its renewable energy projects.

That's enough revenue to cover the costs of 79% of the county's Community Improvement Plan priorities.

Notably, this revenue would be enough to cover **96% of the costs associated with:** 

- Completing identified paved road repairs;
- Updating the solid waste disposal system; and
- Repairing the Valley Creek Bridge

Renewable energy provides the electricity our homes and businesses need at affordable rates, while also transforming Montana's counties into **economic powerhouses with thriving communities.**
